


#### Contra Costa: Housing Units Issued vs. Population (1970-2016)




### Gross Rent as a % of Household Income Danville




#### Gross Rent as a % of Household Income: Walnut Creek




# Walnut Creek Total Housing Units vs. Population (2010-2016)
